Fun Fun Daycare Re-Opening: Health & Safety Guidelines

We are committed to providing our children, families, and staff with a safe and friendly environment at FFDC especially during this critical time. As we begin to re-open our facility, we are guided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE), and the Office of Child Care (OCC) to provide enhanced protocols ensuring the health and safety within our facility. Many of our operational procedures will be adjusted including:

New Entrance Protocols:

- Entrance area will be set up for temperature checks and health screenings at drop-off time. Unfortunately, <u>no parents or other visitors will be permitted inside the facility</u> <u>until further notice</u>.
- We kindly ask that <u>no more than two children be dropped off/picked up at the same</u> <u>time</u> as we try to maintain social distancing between each child and parent. We understand that this will prolong the drop off and pick up time, and we greatly appreciate your patience and cooperation.

Strictly Enforced Sick Policy:

- Children and staff will not be allowed to enter the facility if they show a fever of 100.4 °F (38 °C) or higher.
- Children will not be allowed to enter without a doctor's note if they are showing any one or more of the following COVID-19 symptoms:

-Fever, skin rash, difficulty breathing, vomiting, diarrhea

Health & Safety Parent Agreement

Please read and initial the following to acknowledge that you understand and agree to our new health & safety guidelines.

_____ I understand that if my child has a fever (100.4 °F / 38 °C or greater), other signs of illness, or if any persons in our household show symptoms of COVID-19 that my child will not be admitted into the childcare facility.

_____ I agree to share honest and factual information with FFDC regarding my child and our household members, especially if <u>anyone has traveled outside the DC</u> <u>Metropolitan Area (MD/VA/DC)</u>.

_____ I understand that in order for my child to return to FFDC after showing any COVID-19 symptoms, he/she must bring a signed doctor's note permitting them to return.

_____ I understand that FFDC will remain locked to parents/visitors at all times. I understand that I am not permitted to enter the facility. If I need to pick up my child early, I will notify the facility to let them know.

_____ I understand that FFDC is mandated to contact the local health department and MSDE for guidance regarding closure for persons with confirmed or suspected COVID-19.

** IF THERE IS A CASE OF COVID-19:

_____ I understand that if there is a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 on-site (Ex. A staff member or child), that FFDC will consult with the health department and follow their guidance on necessary steps, which may include closure. We will notify families immediately of our plan of action upon receiving guidance from the Maryland Health Department.
